Your marriage? Your job? Your kids?

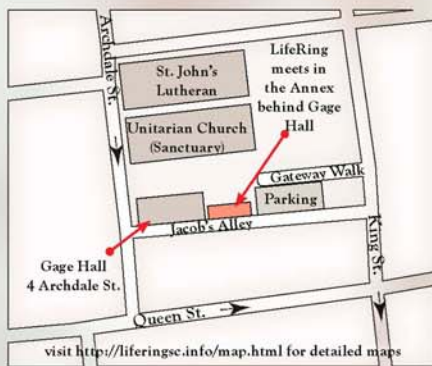
